## The Oratory of St Luke Communion.

In the name of the Father, and the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen**.

(We say together)

Almighty God, unto whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid; cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of thy Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love thee, and worthily magnify thy Holy name; through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Let us humbly confess our sins to Almighty God:

Almighty God, our Heavenly Father, We have sinned against thee, In thought, in word and deed, And in what we have left undone. We are truly sorry and repent of all our sins.

Have mercy upon us, most merciful Father, Forgive us all that is past; And grant that we may ever hereafter Serve and please thee in newness of life, To the honour and glory of thy Name; Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

A prayer will now be said:

## A reading from St. John's Gospel:

God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. (3:16)

## Priest:

As our Saviour Jesus Christ has taught us we are bold to say:

Our Father, who art in heaven,
Hallowed be thy name;
Thy Kingdom come;
Thy will be done;
On earth as it is in Heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread,
And forgive us our trespasses,
As we forgive those who trespass against us.
And lead us not into temptation;
But deliver us from evil.
For thine is the kingdom,
The power, and the glory,
For ever and ever. Amen.

The priest administers Holy Communion:

Receive the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, Given for you, and feed on Him in your Heart(s) by faith with thanksgiving.

The Body of Christ keep you in eternal life. **Amen**. The Blood of Christ keep you in eternal life. **Amen**.

Or

The Body and Blood of Christ keep you in eternal life. **Amen**.

A short silence will follow the administration, and we shall then say together the words from Psalm 103:

Praise the Lord O my soul: and all that is within me praise his Holy name.

Praise the Lord O my soul: and forget not all his benefits; Who forgiveth all my thy sin: and healeth all thine infirmities.

After Communion the following prayer is said:

Gracious Father, we give thee praise and thanksgiving, for this pledge of our redemption, the Holy Communion of the Body and Blood of thy beloved Son, Jesus Christ, whereby we receive forgiveness of our sins, strength in our weakness, and everlasting salvation; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

## Priest:

The peace of God which passes all understanding, keep your heart and mind in the knowledge and love of God, and of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord: And the Blessing of God Almighty, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, be upon you and remain with you always.

Amen.

Let us go forth in peace.
